<b>Cisco Brewery (MA) Sankaty Light</b> <i>This lager with wonderful balance and strong hop finish is unlike most light beers. Reminiscent of an IPA but smooth and easy to drink.</i>	\$3.50
<b>Hog Island (Orleans, MA) White Shark Wheat</b> <i>An American pale wheat ale, with notes of lemon, grass, and wheat. Very pleasant and smooth.</i>	\$3.50
<b>Brooklyn (NY) Lager</b> <i>Amber-gold in color and displays a firm malt center supported by a fine bitterness and floral hop aroma.</i>	\$4.00
<b>Fiddlehead (VT) Second Fiddle</b> <i>A smooth-sipping double IPA; clean and well balanced with pleasing bitterness on the finish</i>	\$4.50
<b>Devil's Purse (Dennis, MA) Handline Kolsch</b> <i>Mildly hopped German style Kolsch with Vanguard. This unfiltered rendition has pleasant aromas akin to lemon zest and cut grass, with a dry finish and refreshing taste.</i>	\$4.00
