CRAFT BEERS

Cisco Brewery (MA) Sankaty Light – This lager with wonderful balance and a strong hop finish is unlike most light beers. Reminiscent of an IPA, but smooth and easy to drink. 12 oz. bottle **\$3.50**

Brooklyn Lager (NY) Amber – Gold in color and displaying a firm malt center, supported by a refreshing bitterness and floral hop aroma. Smooth, refreshing, and versatile with food. 16 oz. can **\$4.00**

Ballast Point (CA) Sculpin IPA – Sculpin IPA is bright with aromas of apricot, peach, mango, and lemon. Its lighter body also brings out the crispness of the hops. 12 oz. bottle **\$4.00**

Rogue (OR) Hazelnut Brown – A nutty twist on a traditional European Brown Ale. Dark brown in color with a hazelnut aroma, a rich nutty flavor, and a smooth malty finish. 12 oz. bottle **\$4.00**

Maine Beer Company (ME) Mean Old Tom – An American-style stout aged on organic vanilla beans. Intense notes of coffee and dark chocolate lead way to subtle notes of natural vanilla. Flaked oats generate a silky mouth feel. 16.9 oz. bottle **\$8.00**

Cape Cod (MA) Red – A well-balanced deep amber brew with a mouthful of malt flavor and just the right amount of hop character. 16 oz. can **\$4.00**

Crispin (MN) Brownlane Cider – A lightly sparkling, crisply effervescent cider made with traditional English bittersweet cider. 16.9 oz. can **\$4.00**

What's in James' Fridge? James' Fridge is stocked with his current pick and changes on a whim. Currently, his selection is **Devil's Purse (Dennis, MA) Skywave Provisional Saison**. Golden amber in color with a fruity, earthy, and spicy aroma reminiscent of cloves, cracked pepper, candied ginger, banana, and dried citrus peel. Pine Ridge Chenin Blanc-Viognier, California – Crisp with papaya, pear, grapefruit, and hints of tangerine and white tea flavors. **\$8/16.00**

Casey Flat Ranch "Estate" Sauvignon Blanc, California – Rich and creamy with aromas of melon, papaya, persimmon, and nectarine. **\$10/22.00**

Trimbach Pinot Gris Reserve Alsace – Full-bodied with peach, pear, and tropical flavors and a long, nutty finish. **\$11/22.00**

Seghesio Arneis, California – Complex and full-bodied with notes of pear and apricot and a crisp acidity. **\$23.00**

Limestone Hill Chardonnay, South Africa – Impeccably pure, refreshing apple, peach, and lemon fruit; a lovely richness of texture; and a nutty, chalky, fruit-filled finish of imposing length. **\$10/19.00**

La Chablisienne Chablis La Pierrelee Burgundy, France – Flower and citrus flavors; perfectly balanced richness and acidity. 375 ml – **\$12.00**

Rose:

Revolver Blood and Roses Napa Cabernet Sauvignon – Merlot and Petit Verdot blend with strawberry, raspberry, and hibiscus. **\$23.00**

Red:

A to Z Pinot Noir, Oregon – Layers of cherry, tobacco, and cocoa mingling against refined tannins with a light finish. 375 ml – **\$14.00**

Rex Hill Pinot Noir Willamette Valley, Oregon – Complex, concentrated blackberry, blueberry, black raspberry, and dark cherry flavors with lingering hints of coffee and cocoa powder. **\$32.00**

Planeta, Cerasuolo di Vittoria, Sicily – 60% Nero d'Avola, 40% Frappato; Vibrant and juicy with strawberry, fig, and cherry flavors. **\$10/21.00**

Elyse C'Est Si Bon, California – Plums, raspberries, and apple give way to a smooth texture and light acidity. **\$27.00**

La Posta Angel Paulucci Malbec, Argentina – Vibrant red color with aromas of red cherries, raspberries, and violets, and notes of toasty oak. **\$8/16.00**

Josh Cellars Legacy, California – A medium-bodied, bold red blend with notes of deep fruit, spice, and crushed black pepper. **\$8/15.00**

First Crush visZINary Harwich, Cape Cod – 75% Zinfandel, 25% Petit Syrah; fruit forward with black cherries, jam, and spice. **\$11/20.00**

Gunsight Rock Cabernet Sauvignon, California – Black fruit with notes of black licorice and a spicy finish. **\$11/20.00**

Storybook Antaeus, Napa – A rich Cabernet and Zinfandel blend beautifully balanced with berry, violets, and Earl Grey tea. **\$42.00**
